



# Kızılaykart Conditional Cash Transfer for Education

May 2019, Monthly Report



The programme assistance encourages families with children in school age and limited financial means to send their children to the school. As of May 2017, assistances within the scope of the Extension of the CCTE Programme for foreigners have started. The CCTE Programme is funded by ECHO, BPRM of the U.S. State Department, and the Government of Norway. The programme is implemented in cooperation with MoFLSS, MoNE, TRC, and UNICEF. The CCTE Programme support students from kindergarten to 12<sup>th</sup> grade with the condition that they do not miss school for more than 4 days in a month.

**CCTE Programme is a conditional and unrestricted cash transfer modality carried out by a bank card.**

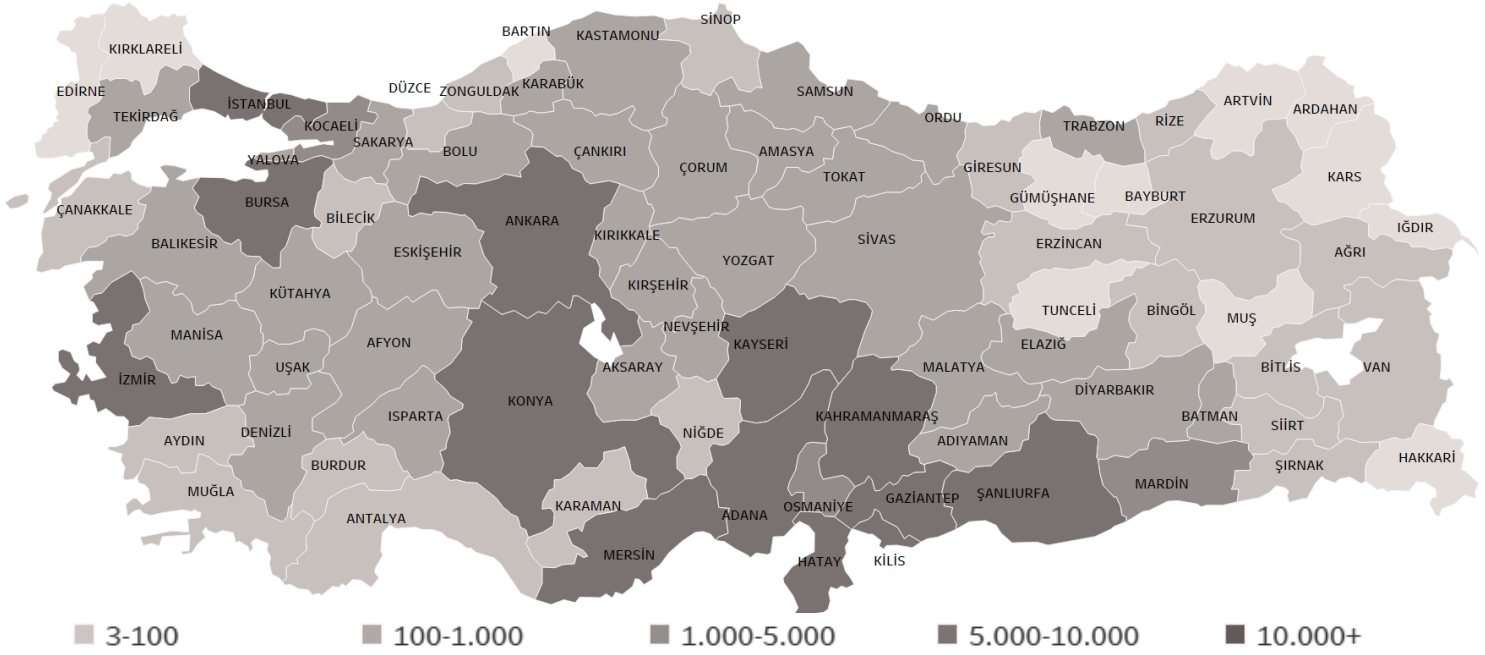

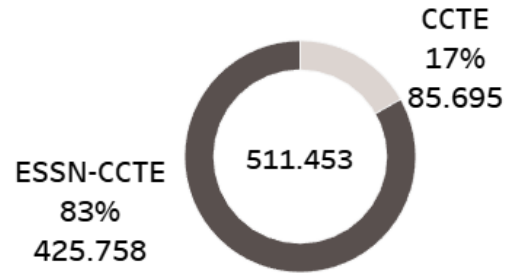

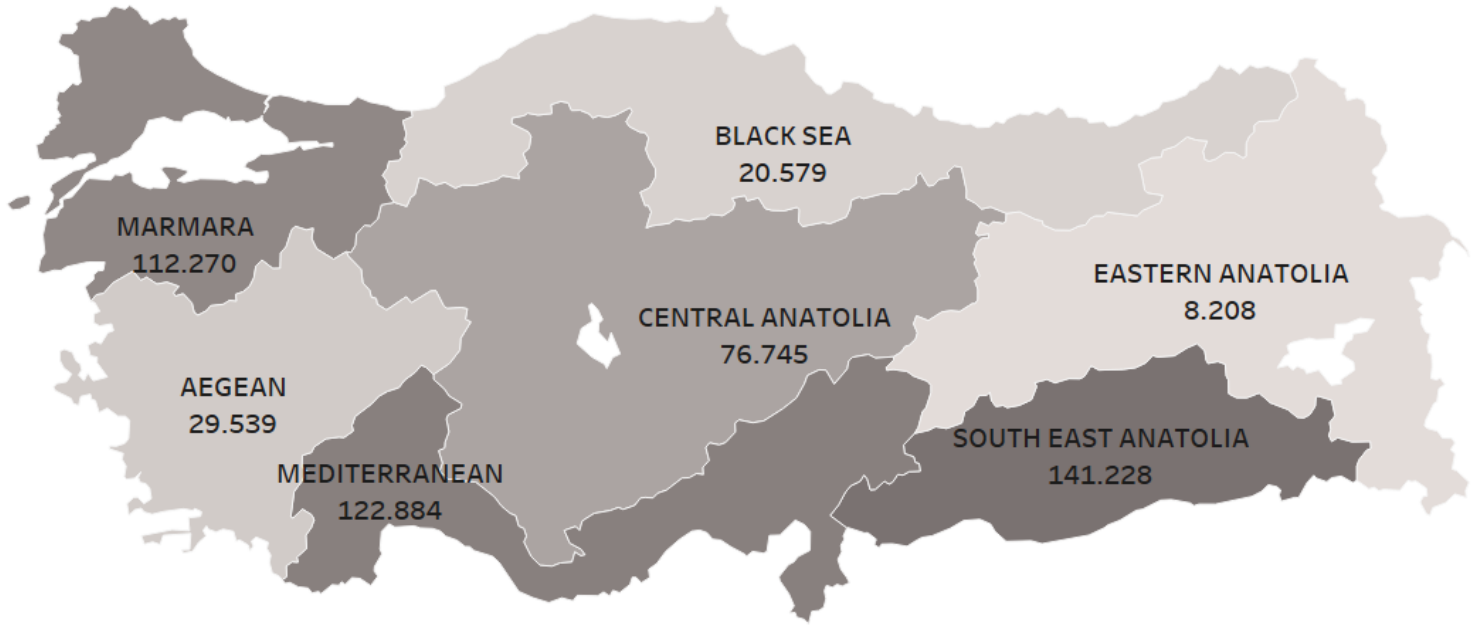

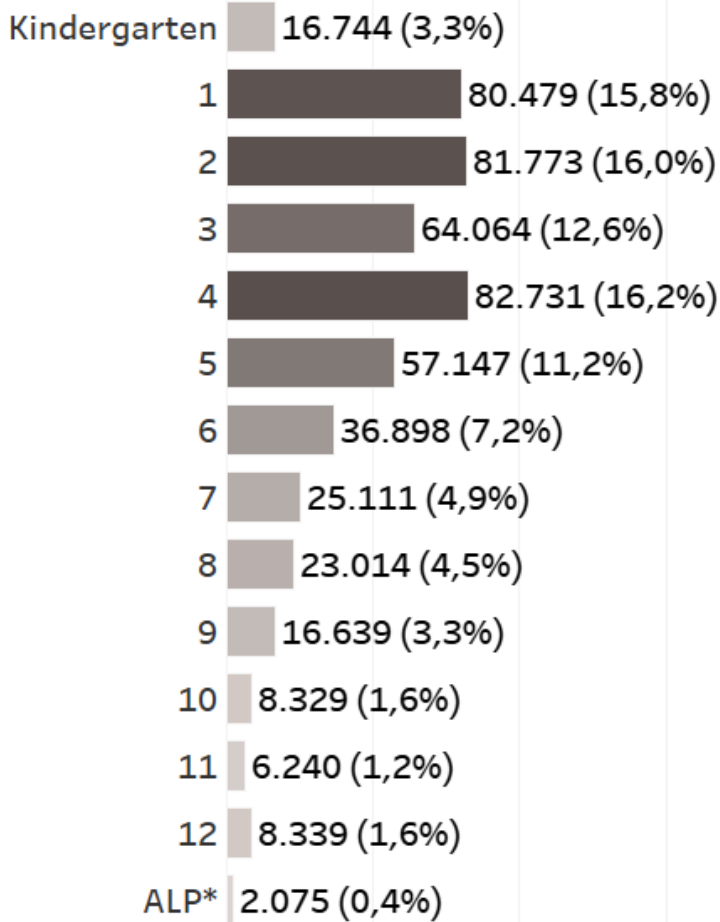

## Grade Breakdown

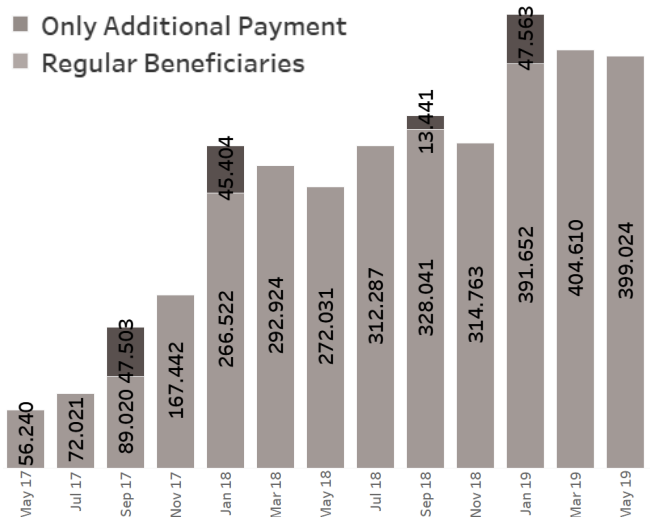
