



Kızılaykart Conditional Cash Transfer for Education

September 2019, Monthly Report



The programme assistance encourages families with children in school age and limited financial means to send their children to the school. As of May 2017, assistances within the scope of the Extension of the Conditional Cash Transfer for Education (CCTE) Programme for foreigners have started. The CCTE Programme is funded by EU's Directorate General for European Civil Protection and Humanitarian Aid Operations, the Bureau of Population, Refugees and Migration (PRM) of the US State Department, and the Government of Norway. The programme is implemented in cooperation with Ministry of Family, Labor, and Social Services, Ministry of National Education, Türk Kızılay, and UNICEF. The CCTE Programme support students from kindergarten to 12th grade with the condition that they do not miss school for more than 4 days in a month.

➤ CCTE Programme is a **conditional and unrestricted** cash transfer modality carried out by a bank card.

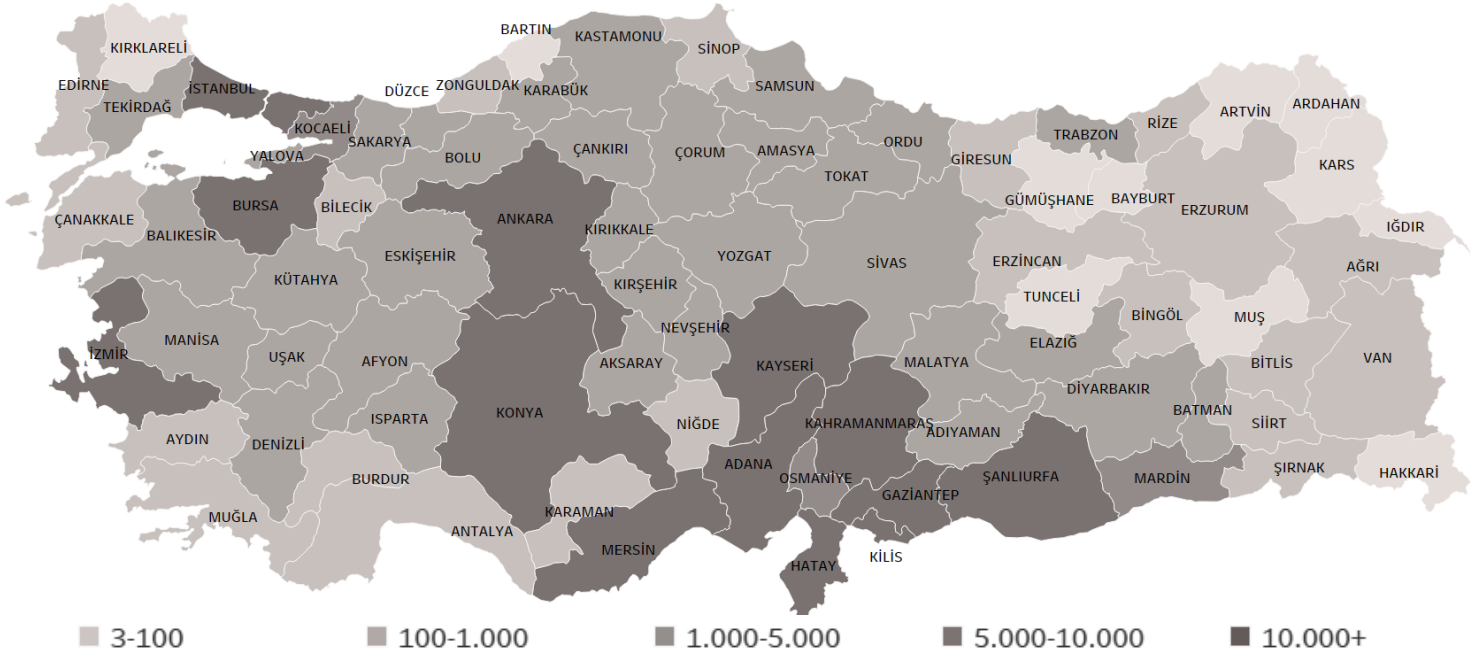

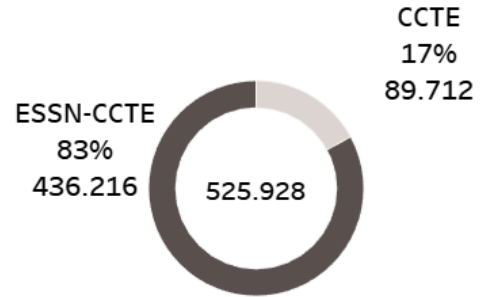

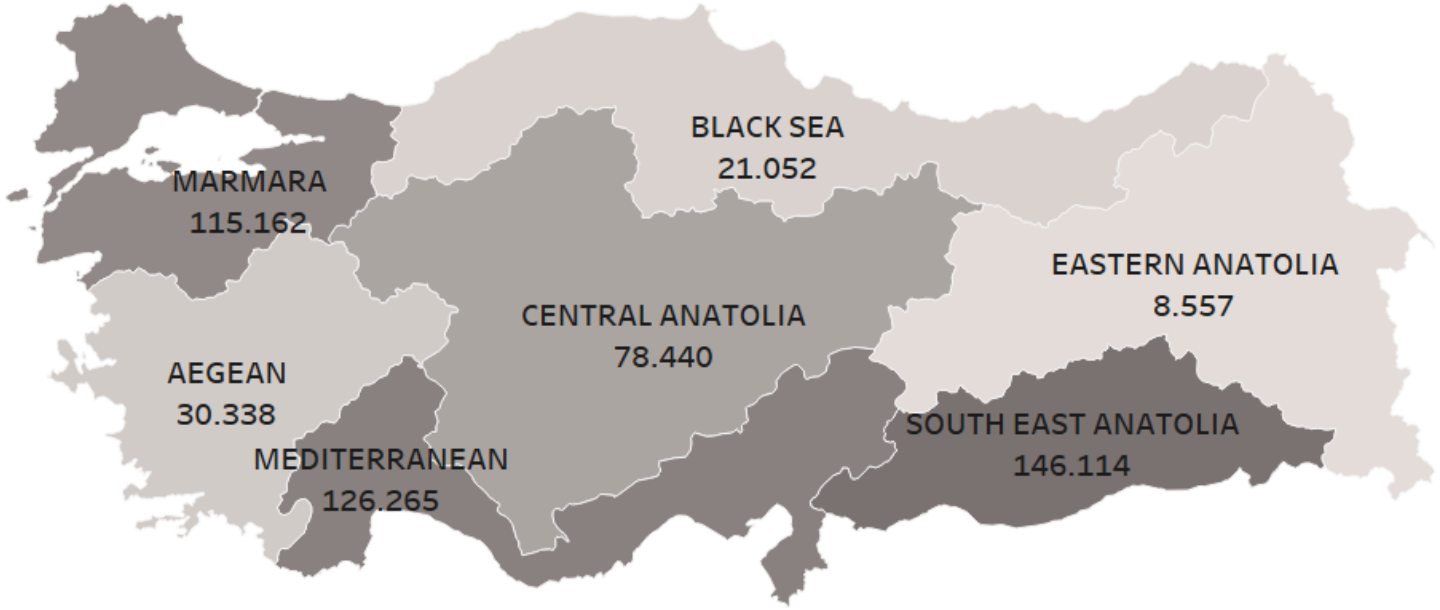

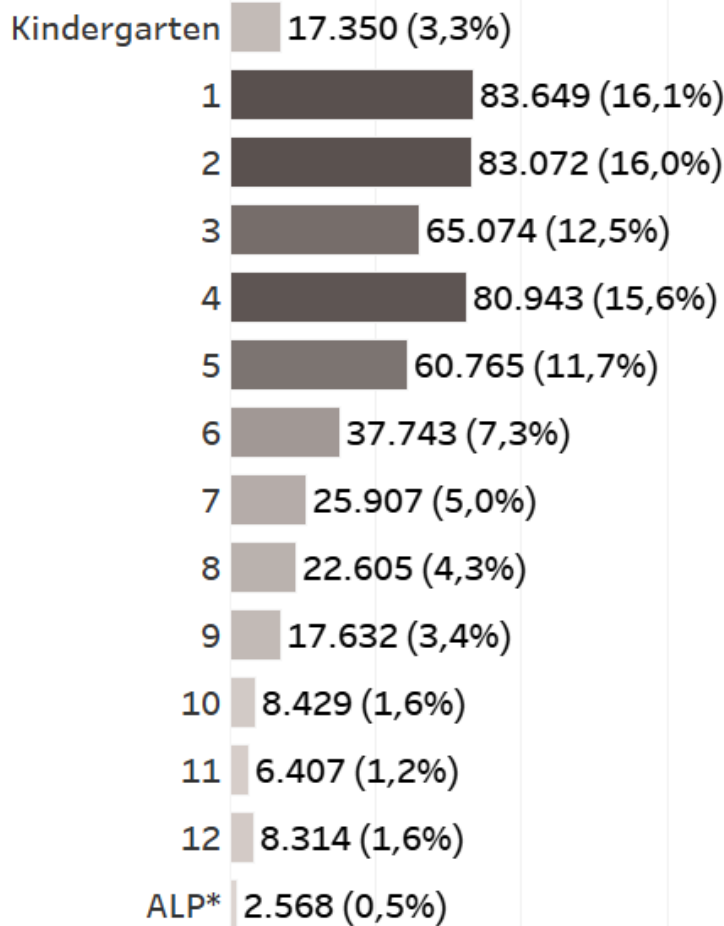

Beneficiaries by Regions



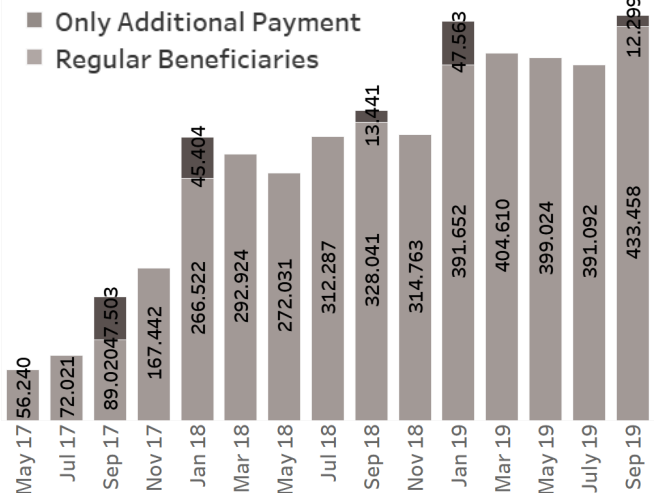
