Conditional Cash Transfer for Education (CCTE) Programme

The programme encourages families with children of school age and limited financial means to send their children to school regularly. As of May 2017, assistance within the CCTE Programme for foreigners have started. The program is funded by the ECHO, Population, Refugees and Immigration Administration, the US Department of Foreign Affairs and the Government of Norway. The Programme is implemented in cooperation with the MoFLSS, the Ministry of Education, the Turkish Red Crescent and UNICEF.

CCTE Programme is a conditional cash transfer modality carried out by a Kızılaykart bank card.

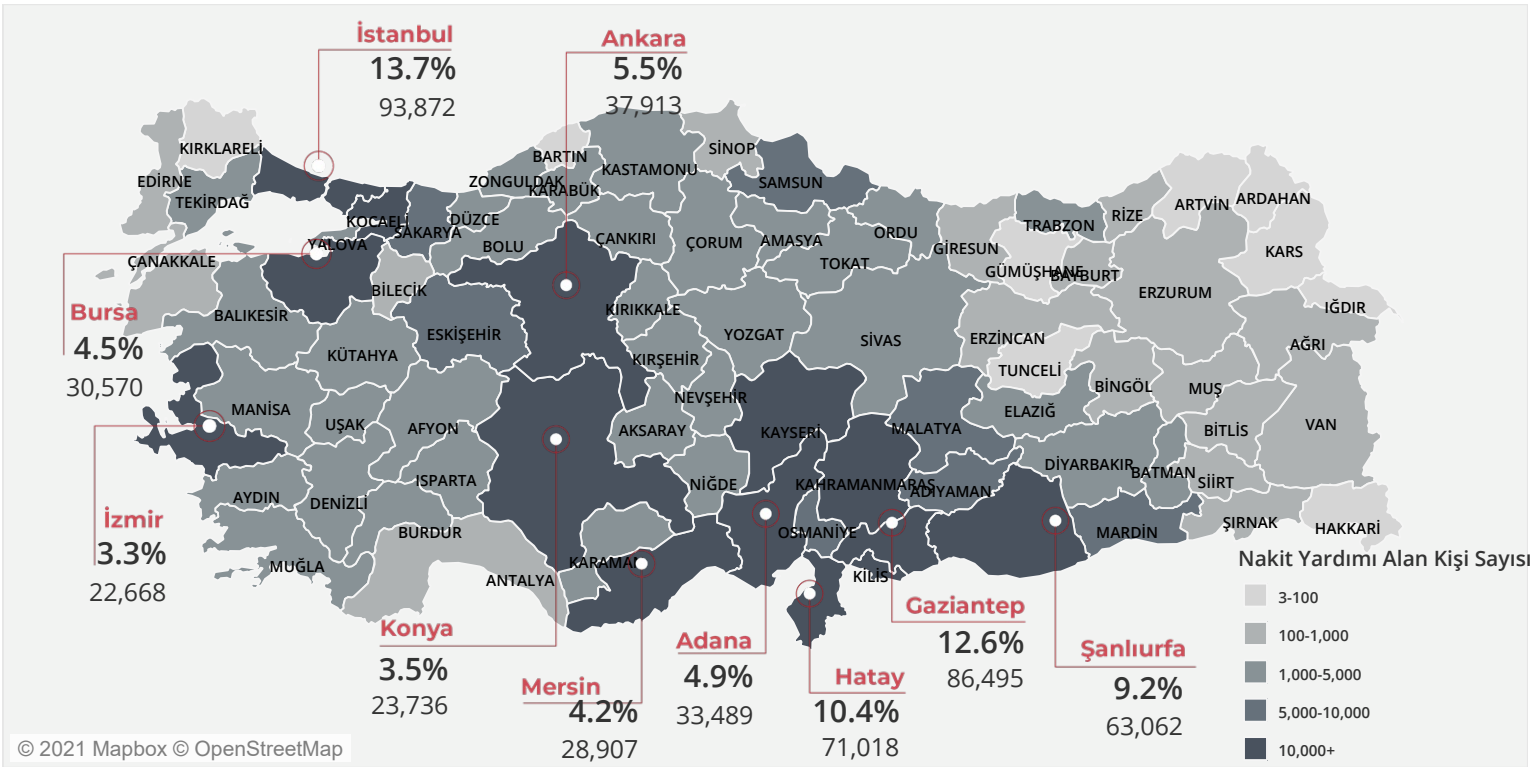

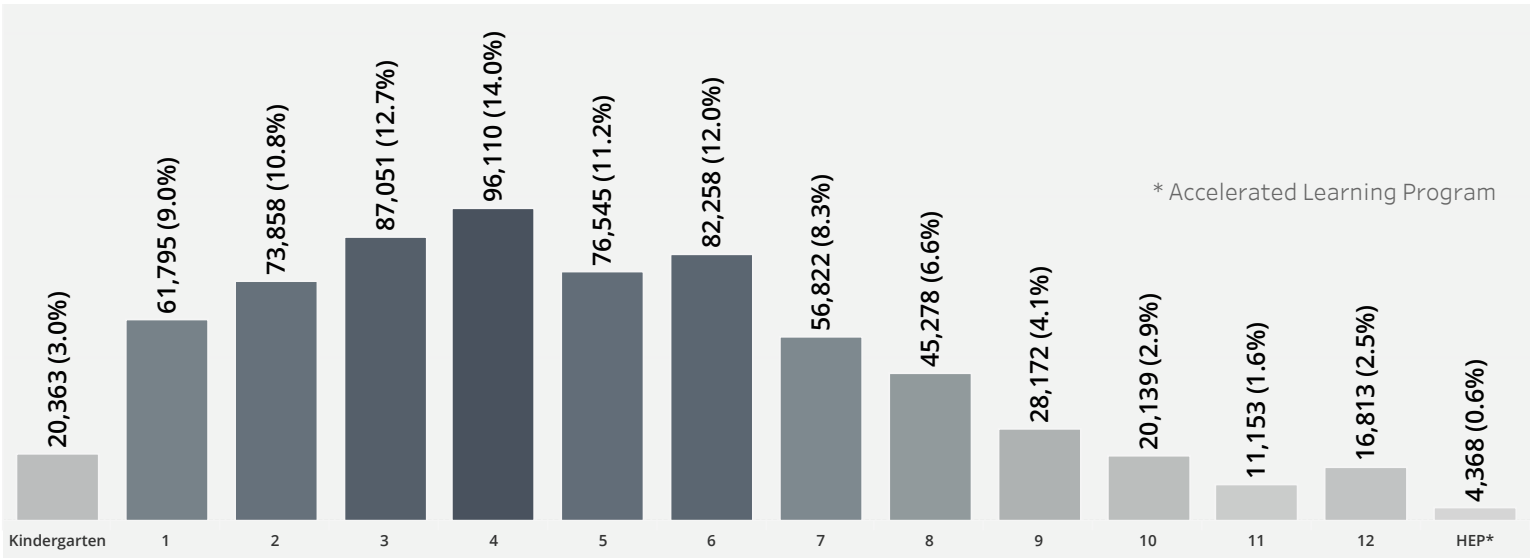


Top 10 Provinces with Highest Number of People Receiving Regular Assistance
