



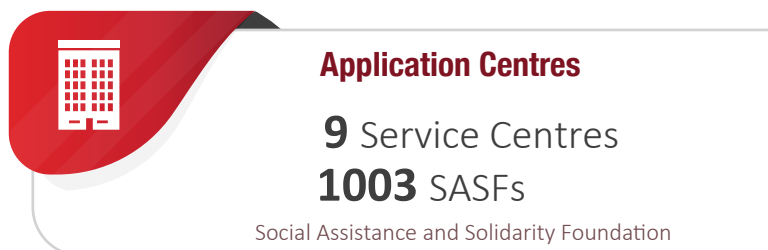
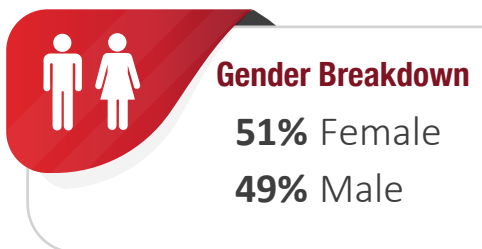
Kızılaykart Emergency Social Safety Net Programme

The ESSN Programme is funded by European Civil Protection and Humanitarian Aid Operations (ECHO) and is implemented in cooperation with Ministry of Family, Labor and Social Services, TRC, and UN World Food Programme (WFP).

ESSN Programme is an unconditional and unrestricted cash transfer modality carried out by a bank card.



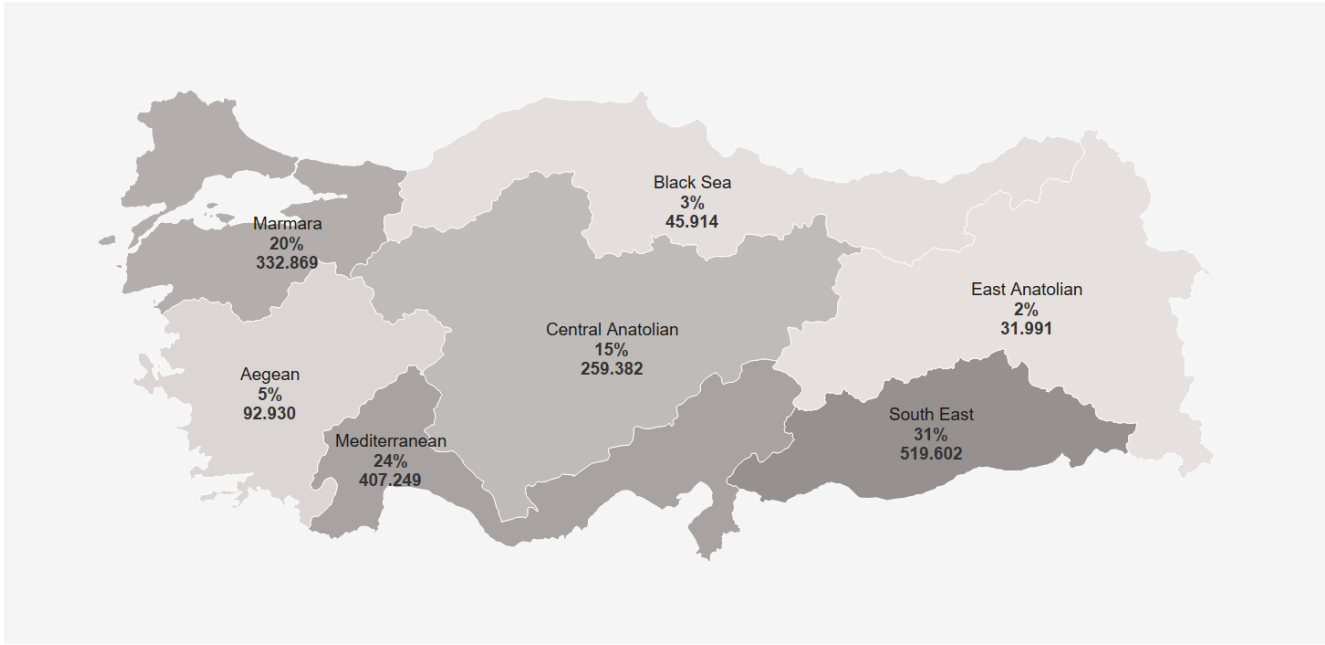

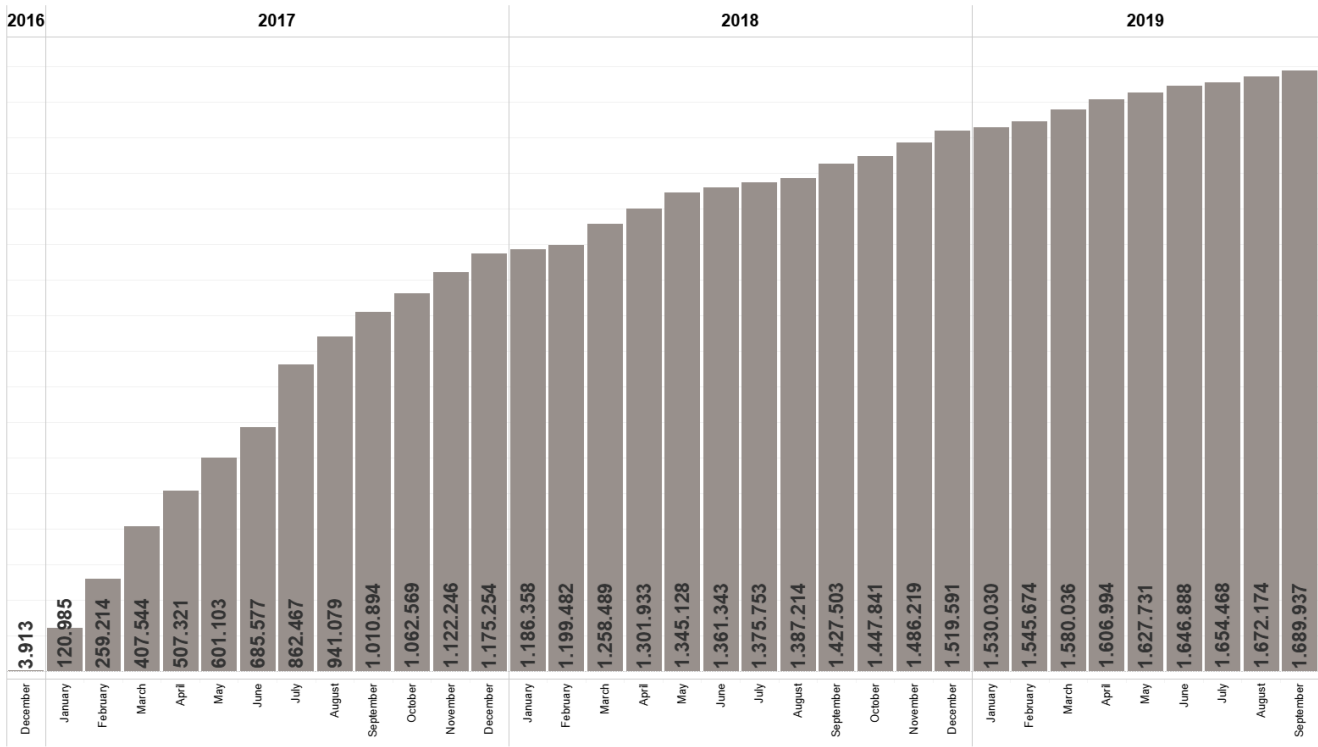




Regional Breakdown of Beneficiaries
