



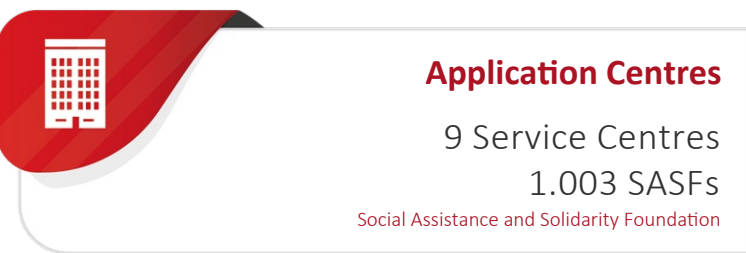
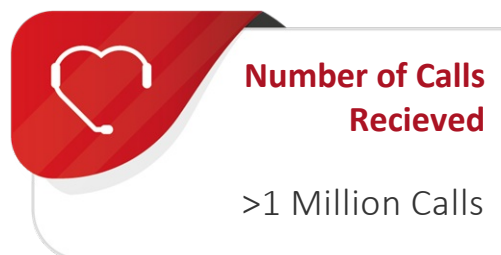
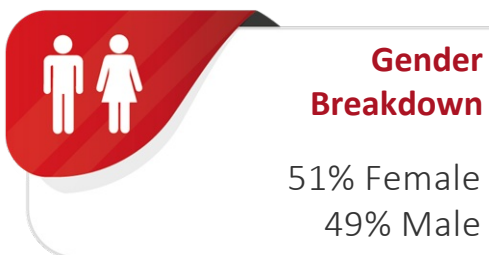
Kızılaykart Emergency Social Safety Net Programme (ESSN)

Emergency Social Safety Net Programme (ESSN) has been designed to meet the basic needs of the foreigners residing outside the camps in Turkey in a dignified manner; those who are under International Protection and Temporary Protection. The ESSN Programme is funded by European Civil Protection and Humanitarian Aid Operations (ECHO) and is implemented in cooperation with Ministry of Family, Labor and Social Services, TRC, and UN World Food Programme (WFP).

ESSN Programme is an **unconditional** and **unrestricted** cash transfer modality carried out by a bank card.



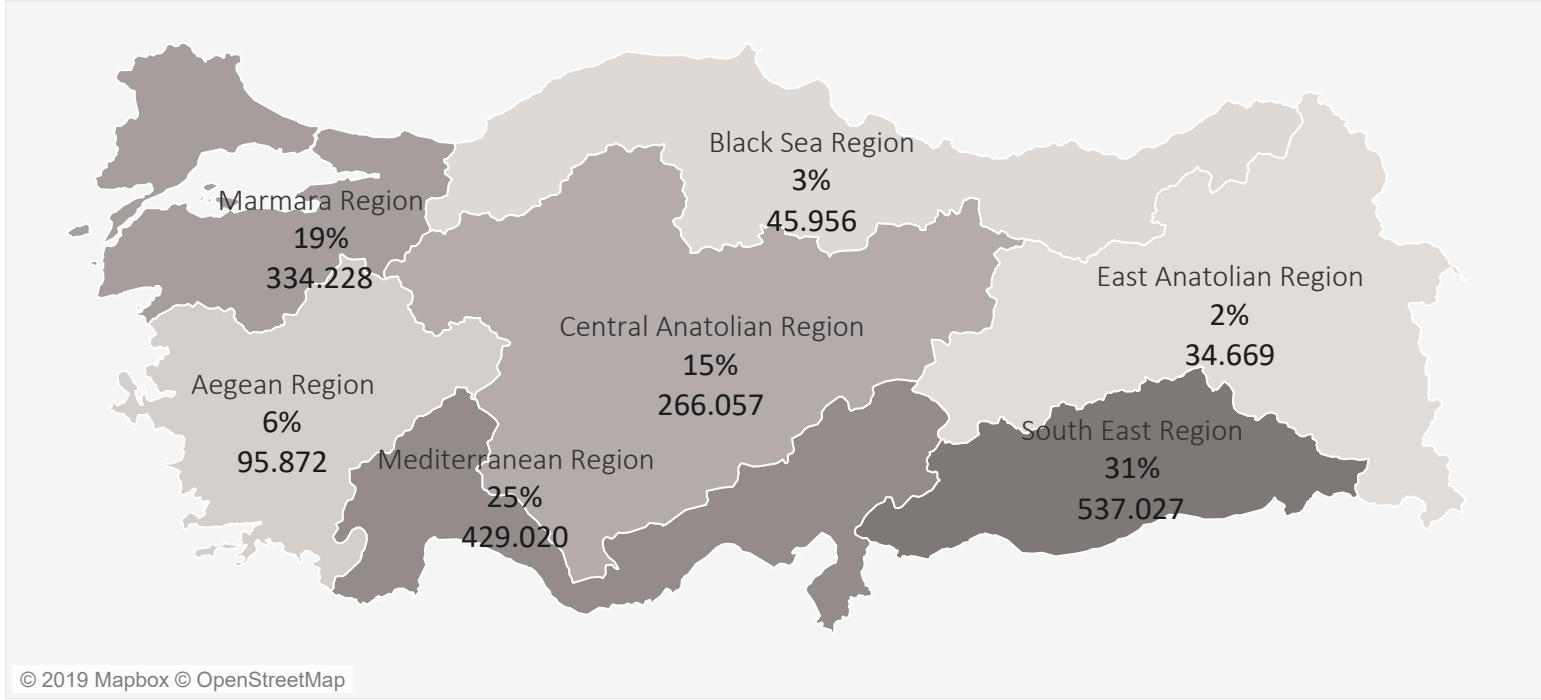

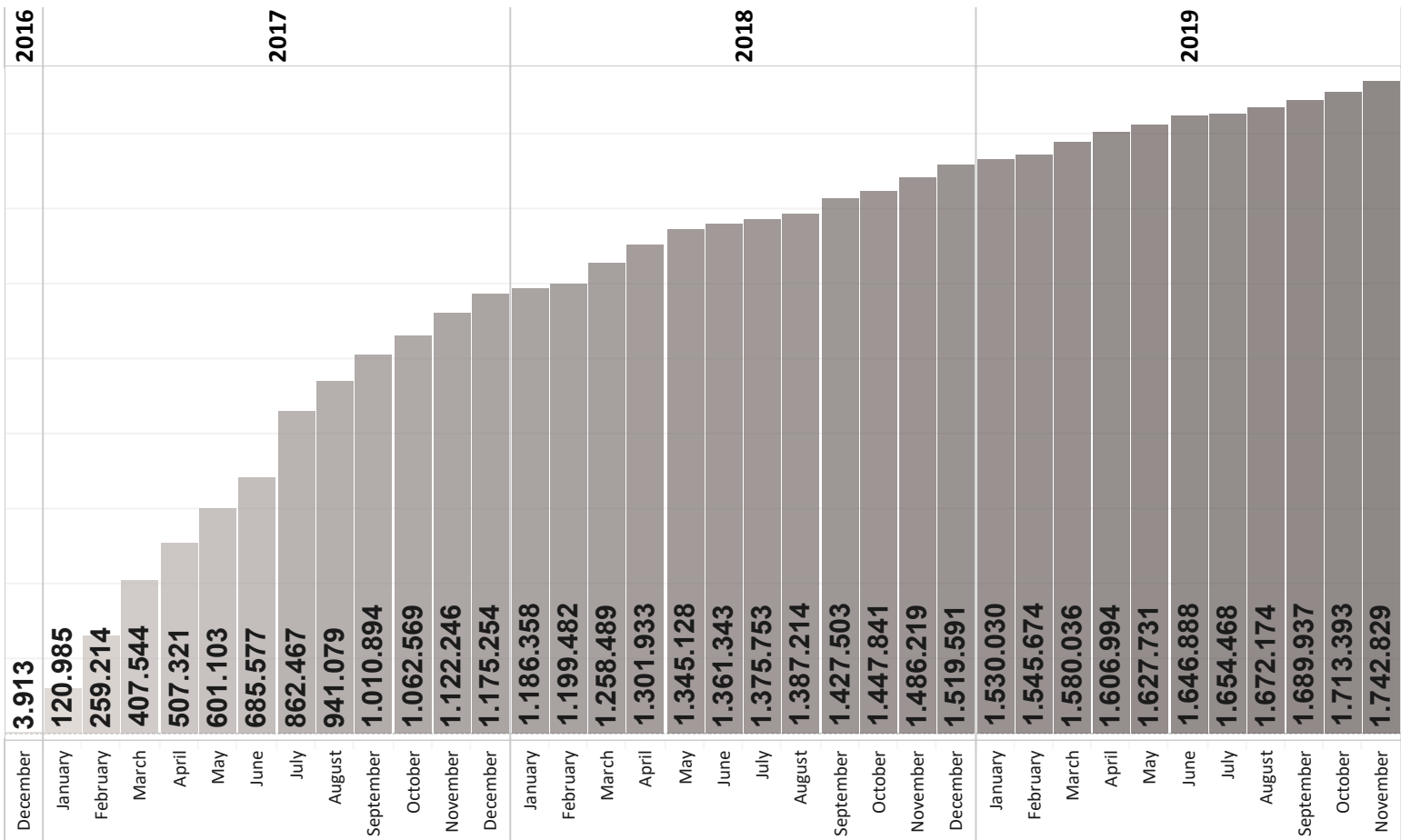




Regional Breakdown of Beneficiaries

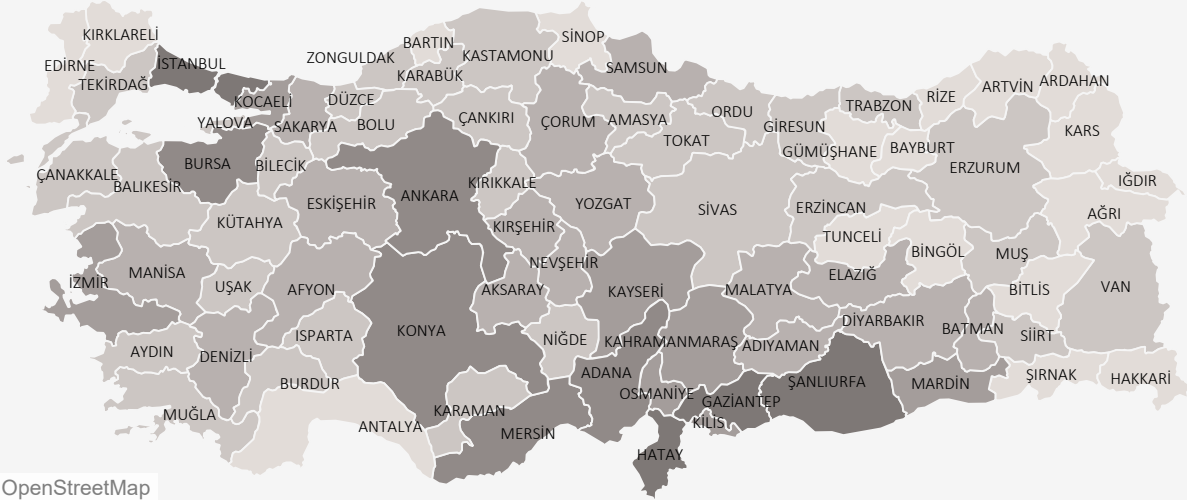


Number of Monthly Beneficiaries
