Emergency Social Safety Net (ESSN) Programme

Programme, has been designed to meet the basic needs of the foreigners residing outside the camps in Turkey in **a dignified manner**; those who are under International Protection and Temporary Protection. The ESSN Programme is funded by ECHO and is implemented in cooperation with Ministry of Family, Labour and Social Services, Turkish Red Crescent (Türk Kızılay) and IFRC. **ESSN is an unconditional cash transfer modality** carried out by a bank card.

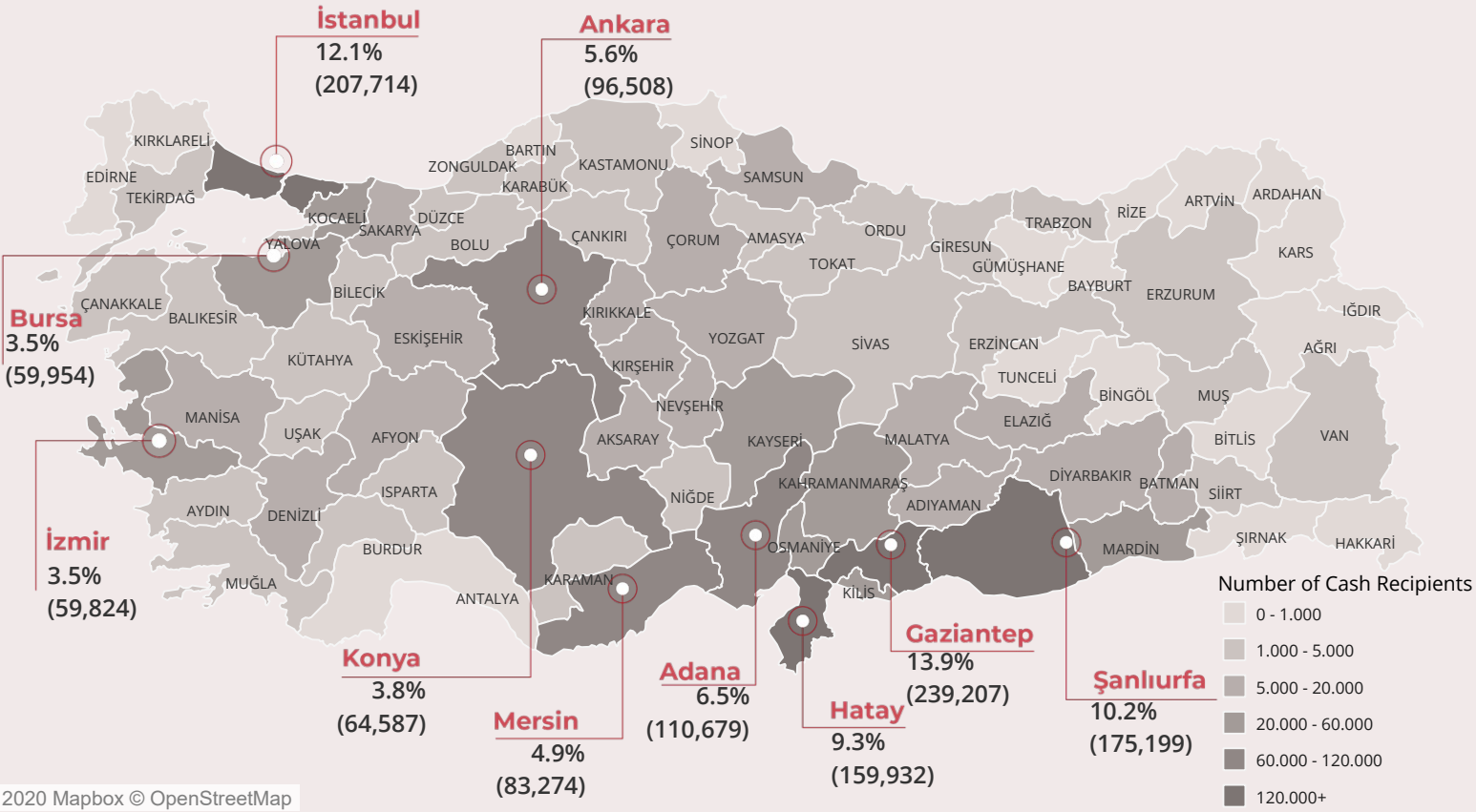

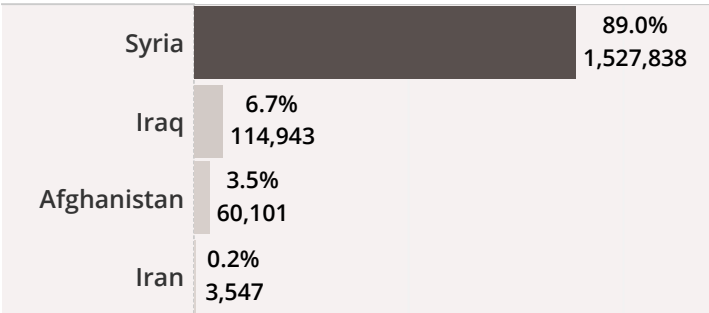




Top Ten Provinces with Highest Number of People Receiving Regular Assistance



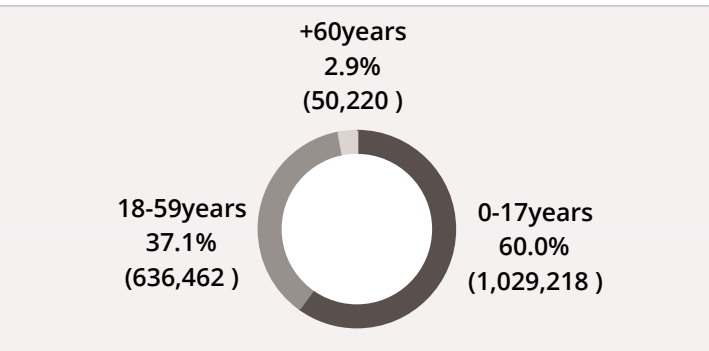
Nationality Breakdown (Top 4 Nationalities)



Criteria Breakdown

Families with four or more children.	55.5%	952,698
Families that have a high number of 'dependents'. This is determined as families that have at least 1.5 dependents for every able bodied adult.	23.3%	399,635
Families with one or more disabled people. They must have a disability of 40% or more.	9.1%	156,503
Single parents with no other adults in the family and at least one child under 18.	9.1%	155,939
Single female.	0.8%	14,269
Elderly people above 60 with no other adults in the family.	0.4%	7,601
