







Top Ten Provinces with Highest Number of People Receiving Regular Assistance



Criteria Breakdown

Families with four or more children.	55.6%	974,804
Families that have a high number of 'dependents'. This is determined as families that have at least 1.5 dependents for every able bodied adult.	23.3%	407,782
Families with one or more disabled people. They must have a disability of 40% or more.	9.1%	159,718
Single parents with no other adults in the family and at least one child under 18.	9.0%	157,841
Single female.	0.8%	14,670
Elderly people above 60 with no other adults in the family.	0.4%	7,746
