







## **Top Ten Provinces with Highest Number of People Receiving Regular Assistance**


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## **Nationality Breakdown (Top 4 Nationalities)**

Families with four or more children.	55.5%	1,004,296
Families that have a high number of 'dependents'. This is determined as families that have at least 1.5 dependents for every able bodied adult.	23.4%	422,587
Families with one or more disabled people. They must have a disability of 40% or more.	9.1%	163,794
Single parents with no other adults in the family and at least one child under 18.	9.0%	162,556
Single female.	0.9%	15,673
Elderly people above 60 with no other adults in the family.	0.4%	8,106
