



## Emergency Social Safety Net (ESSN) Programme

Programme, has been designed to meet the basic needs of the foreigners residing outside the camps in Turkey in **dignity**; those who are under International Protection and Temporary Protection. The ESSN Programme is funded by ECHO and is implemented in cooperation with Ministry of Family, Labour and Social Services, Turkish Red Crescent (Türk Kızılay) and IFRC. **ESSN** is an **unconditional** cash transfer modality carried out by a bank card.

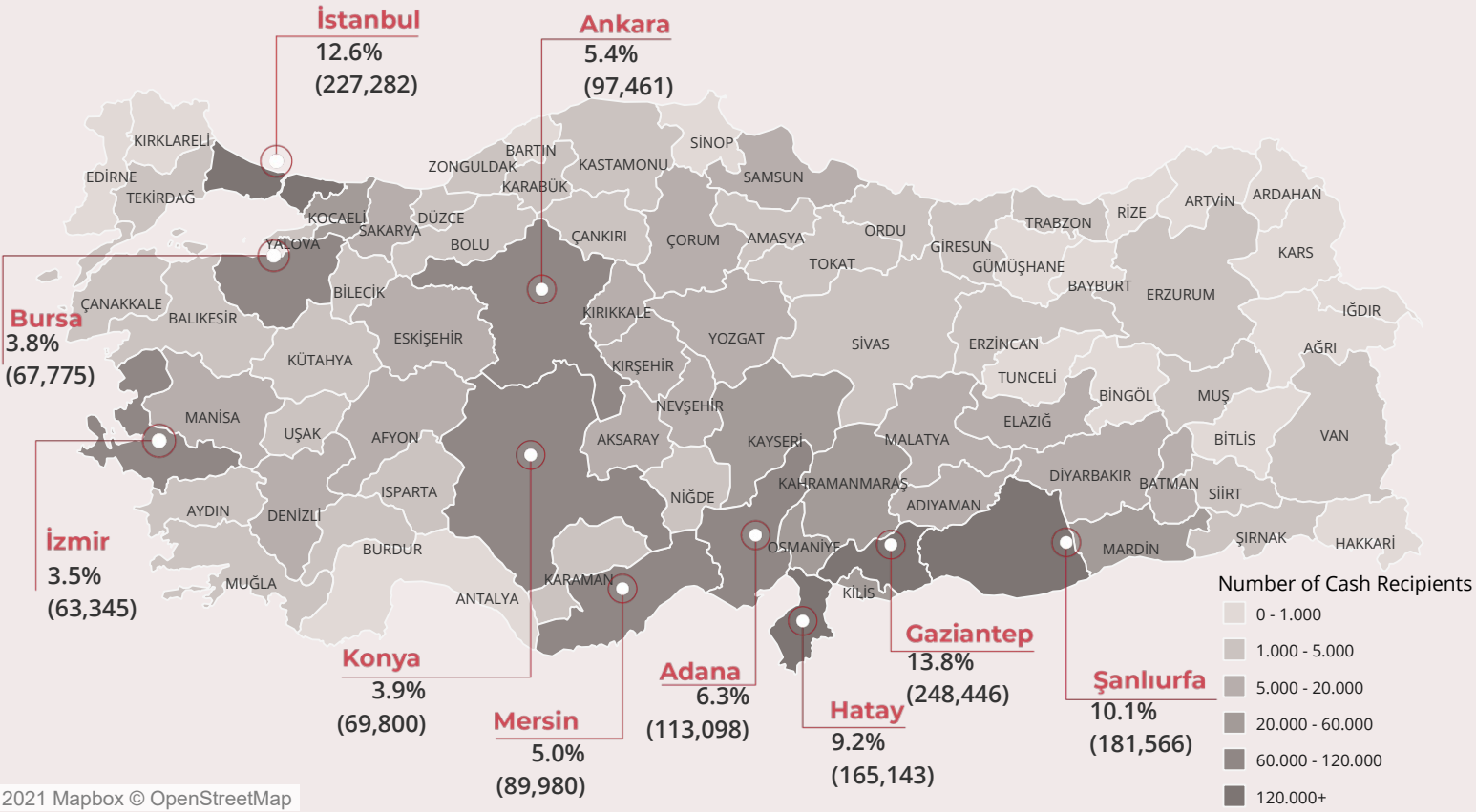

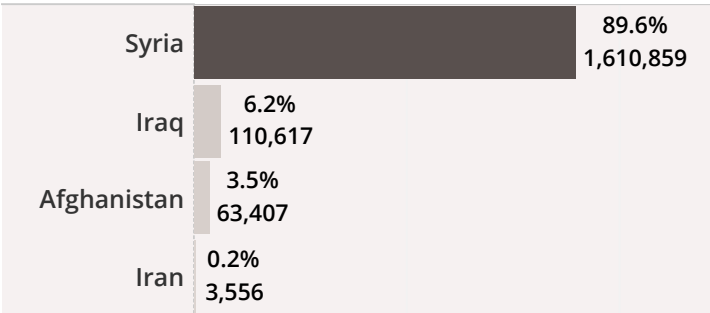


## Top Ten Provinces with Highest Number of People Receiving Regular Assistance

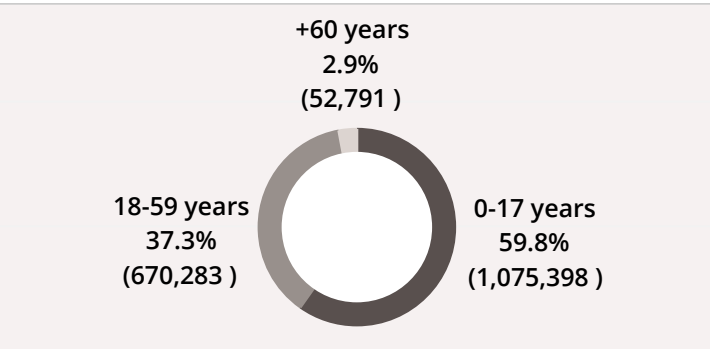

Families with four or more children.	55.3%	995,100
Families that have a high number of 'dependents'. This is determined as families that have at least 1.5 dependents for every able bodied adult.	23.3%	419,729
Families with one or more disabled people. They must have a disability of 40% or more.	9.2%	166,157
Single parents with no other adults in the family and at least one child under 18.	9.0%	161,134
Single female.	0.9%	16,017
Elderly people above 60 with no other adults in the family.	0.5%	8,137

\* 32,198 People (1.8%) who do not meet the demographic criteria but whose vulnerability is observed receive cash support through the SASF allowance.
