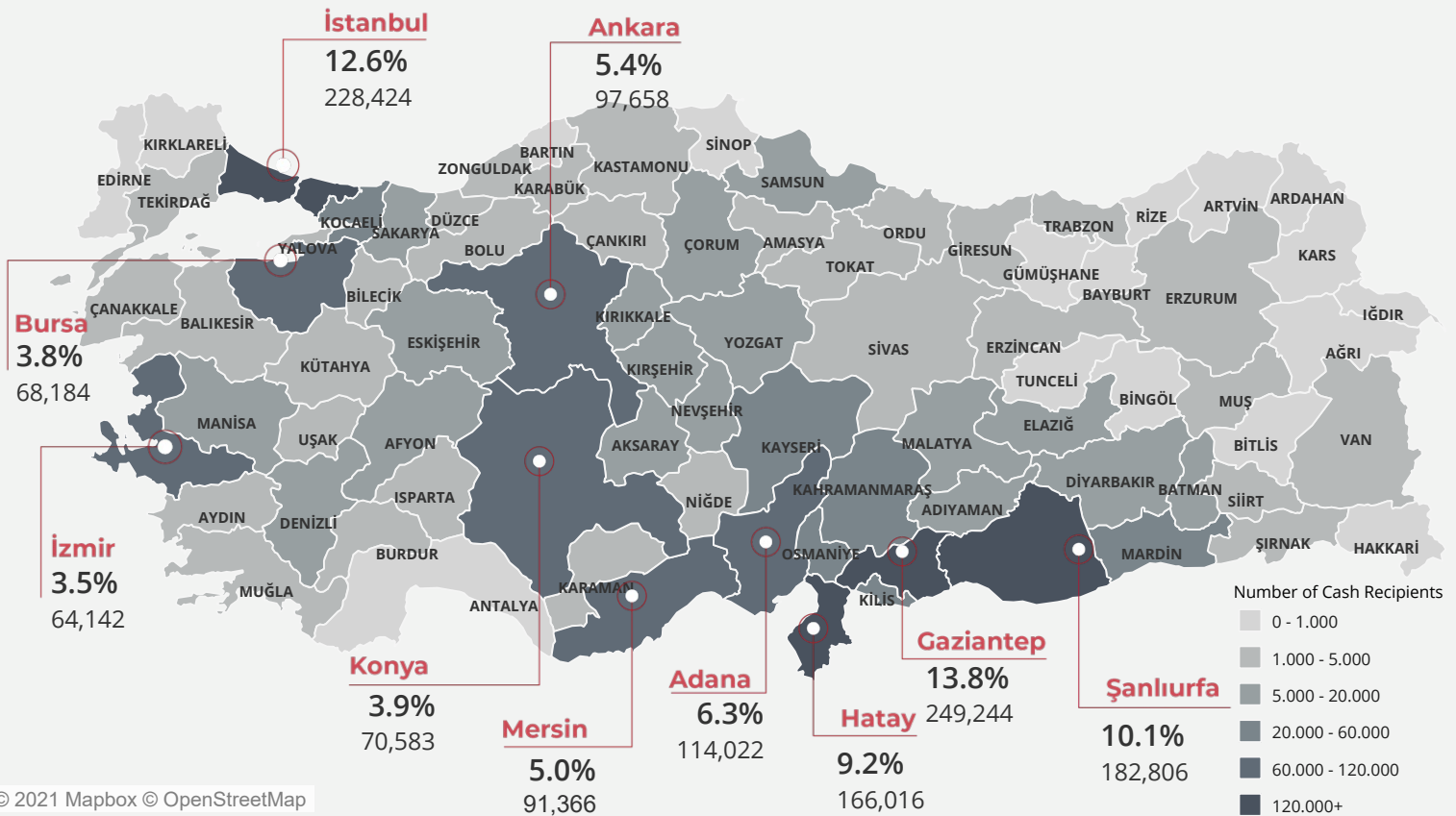

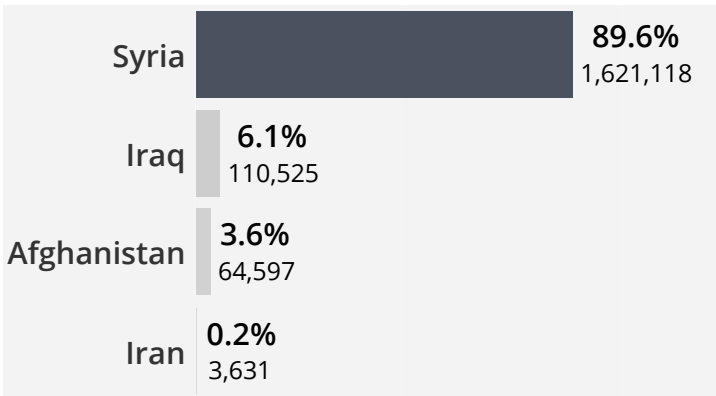
## Top Ten Provinces with Highest Number of People Receiving Regular Assistance

### Criteria Breakdown

Families with four or more children.	55.4%	1,002,784
Families that have a high number of 'dependents'. This is determined as families that have at least 1.5 dependents for every able bodied adult.	23.5%	425,591
Families with one or more disabled people. They must have a disability of 40% or more.	9.3%	167,680
Single parents with no other adults in the family and at least one child under 18.	8.6%	156,412
Single female.	0.9%	16,310
Elderly people above 60 with no other adults in the family.	0.5%	8,163

\* 32,959 People (1.8%) who do not meet the demographic criteria but whose vulnerability is observed receive cash support through the SASF allowance.
